4 WAYS TO HELP YOUR PRESCHOOLER DEVELOP PROBLEM-SOLVING SKILLS

- 1 Practice positive problem-solving
Use positive words to resolve conflicts.
- 2 Include your child in family discussions to help them cooperate with the decision.
- 3 Monitor your child's TV, video, or computer choices & talk about what is being seen.
- 4 Use the IDEAL model of social problem solving.

- I** Identify the problem. Stop, calm down, and think.
- D** Determine your choices. What can be done?
- E** Evaluate your choice. Consider the consequence.
- A** Act on your best choices.
- L** Learn from the results of your actions.
