- Please alert us either by email, phone, or through Procare of any changes to your child's daily pick-up/drop off routine. This is especially important if someone other than your child's parent is picking up.
 - Anybody who is not a parent must have a signed "Release Form". These can be given to you by your child's teacher.

Everyone picking up must have an ID.

- The door will be monitored between the hours of 7:30-9:00 AM and 3:30-5:30 PM. If the door is locked you must call the office to be let in. Please be patient as it may take some time.
- Please continue to update us, or the office, of your child's vaccination status and other health reports..
 - All medicines/prescriptions must be kept in their original containers and held in Connie's office.

Center-Wide News

Welcome to the start of our **2025-26 school year**! We hope everyone had a great summer and are looking forward to cooler temperatures and the rest of the fun that the fall season brings. The **September Calendar of Events** is posted on the website as well as on the classroom doors.

Every child **must have had breakfast/first bottle before** coming to care.

Every child must have a **yearly physical form** with all shots up to date. If we do not have a current, up-to-date physical on file for your child **PLEASE get this done immediately**. **These PHYSICAL FORMS are DUE EVERY YEAR!** We are in our State Inspection window. Without a current physical we must deny services.

Lunch Orders: There is **NO Thursday lunch** scheduled for the first week of school. (9/4) If you do order lunches, please *remember to provide a drink for the meal.*

*Teachers talk with children during lunch about the **nutritious value of the foods they are eating**, encouraging them to eat foods from all food groups. Please make sure you are providing items from all food groups in their lunches.

*If there is **perishable food** in your child's lunch please label it and we will place it in the refrigerator. Please use **ice packs** in lunchboxes as well.

Safety:

*As with the start of every new school year, we ask for your cooperation with providing proper identification when picking up your child. Since family members are permitted to enter the building, keep your child close to you and be aware of other cars in the parking lot. Speed limit in the parking lot is 5 MPH. Children may not wander the hallways/stairwells without a parent in sight.

*Entrance/Exit Door - our main entrance and exit is the back door off of the playground. This is the only door families may enter or exit the building. All doors to the building are kept locked at all times. The back door is manned from 7:30-9:00 AM and from 3:30-5:30 PM daily.

† Frankiljes must arrive before 9:00 AM and after 3:30 PM to pick up their childrens. Blease try to make appointments during the times the door is manned. If not possible and you need to pick up or drop off during the times the door is not manned, you will need to call the center at 215-572-0862 x202 except on Wednesdays, x200 or 204. It may take a while for 085 to get to the door, so please be patient.
