Safety is one of our main concerns. This entails the help of everyone who comes to Ardsley Center. Please enter and exit the parking lot slowly, **entering from Central and exiting onto Spear. Park in a legal parking spot and turn your car off.** Do not leave children unattended in a car.

Flu Season – If your child gets the flu shot, please inform your child's teacher so we can complete our report for the Center of Disease Control.

COVID-19 –For those old enough, please let us know if your child gets the COVID vaccine or booster(s) Both the flu and COVID shots get recorded on their annual physicals.

***Current health reports are required** for all children enrolled in our program. If your child's health report is missing or expired, please schedule an appointment with your pediatrician. Without an up-to-date health report we are unable to maintain compliance with state regulations and your child's care may be suspended until the paperwork is received. Please let your teacher know when they have a doctor's appointment. You can get the paper off our website as well*
