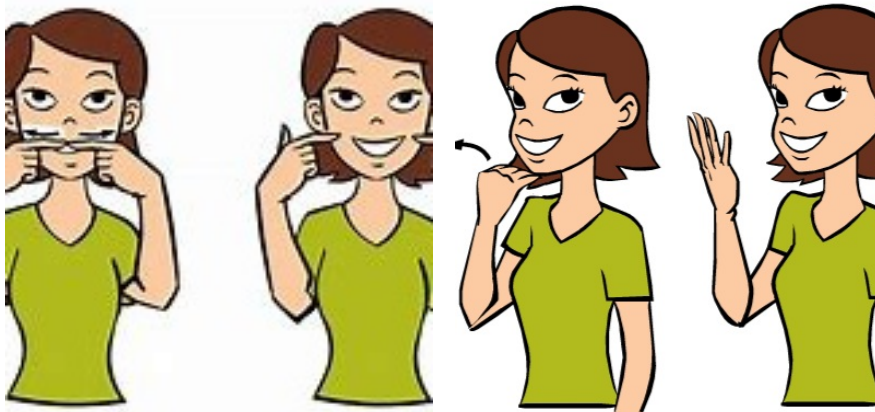
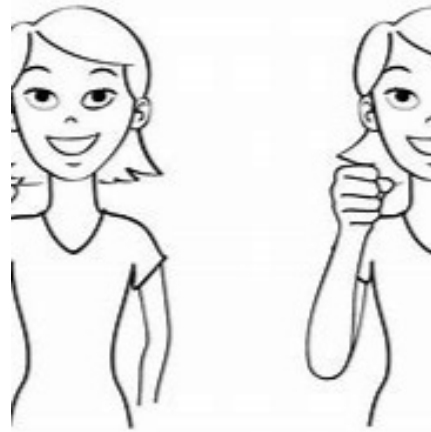

### **OUTSIDE PLAY**

We are enjoying the times we get to go outside. Hopefully we will be able to get outside everyday soon! We will take walks and play with the bikes on the blacktop. Eventually we will be able to take a blanket out on the hill outside and play with the blocks and balls. The older babies love to try and climb the hill.

### **A few reminders:**

At 6 months we would like to introduce them to a sippy cup and let them have it when they are eating their lunch. We will put water in it till they transition from a bottle to a cup. We also start to work with them on holding their own bottles.

At 1 year we like to get them off the bottle and the pacifier. They should also be on finger foods and feed themselves. They are also down to 1 nap a day and are on a cot.

We supply 2 snacks a day so when you have introduced foods at home please let us know and we will start giving them snacks.

### Center Wide News
