Teddy Bear Tips

Explore the outside! Science is all around us. With the weather getting nicer and the days getting longer let your child explore. Take a walk and look at the changes that are happening, let them dig in the dirt and describe what it feels like. Do they find any worms, Rollie Pollies, small rocks? Keep track of when the sun goes down. Write down the time every day for at least a week so they can see each one getting just a little bit longer. These things along with other small activities will help your child understand what it means when the seasons change, what happens to the environment, animals, plants etc. Science/exploring can be in your own backyard

Outside Fun

On our walks we will be looking for the first signs of Spring! We can not wait for the beautiful days of Spring so we can run in the field, practice throwing and kicking, rolling down the hill and just having fun!
