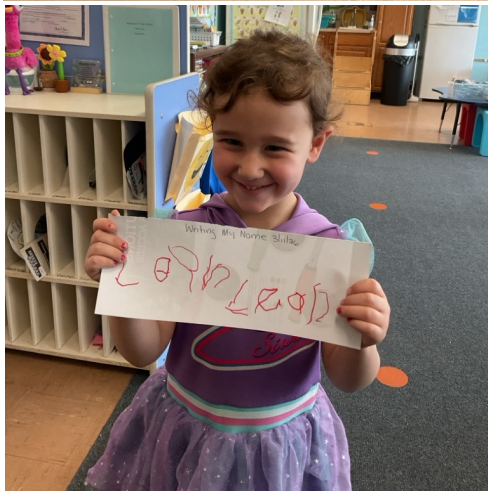


Teddy Bear Tips
