## Tips/Reminders

- Please check regularly that your child has at least **2 sets** of appropriate clothing in their lockers. This includes shoes and socks.
- All items must be labeled.
- Please alert us either by email, phone, or through Procure of any changes to your child's daily pick-up/drop off routine. This is especially important if someone other than your child's parent is picking up and must be ID'd.
  - Anybody who is not a parent must have a signed "Release Form". These can be given to you by your child's teacher.**Everyone picking up must have an ID.**
  - If the door is locked you must call the office to be let in. Please be patient as it may take some time.
- Please continue to update us, or the office, of your child's vaccination status.
  - All medicines/prescriptions must be kept in their original containers and held in Connie's office.

## Happy Father's Day!

With the warmer weather here, your child needs to have appropriate clothing in their lockers/cubbies. Please make sure there are at least 2 complete changes of clothes including socks for your child. **Every item MUST be LABELED with child's name.**

**THURSDAY HOT LUNCHES - Remember to send in a drink!**

### Important safety issues:

- ALL children must **wear totally closed sneakers** every day! No sandals, flip flops, crocs, mountain shoes, etc. are allowed. Woodchips can get into the opening of these shoes which causes safety concerns.
- Children **wearing dresses or skirts MUST wear shorts** underneath.
- **SUNSCREEN must be applied daily to your child before they come in.** We will reapply sunscreen for the afternoon.
- Please make sure you are taking your child to the appropriate bathroom. With summer camp beginning and more children in the building, we ask that men do not enter the women's restroom and women do not enter the men's restroom. If you need to assist your child, please use the single bathrooms located outside of the baby room. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.
- **Please be extra careful in the parking lot with all the new summer campers starting.**

**Congratulations to our graduates.** The Koala Bear's and Pooh Bear's **Graduation** is on Friday, June 5, 2026. They worked hard this year and are more than ready to head off to kindergarten.

Our summer camp rooms will be busy soon and our summer staff is ready with new innovative ideas!
