Wednesday July 22- Bucks

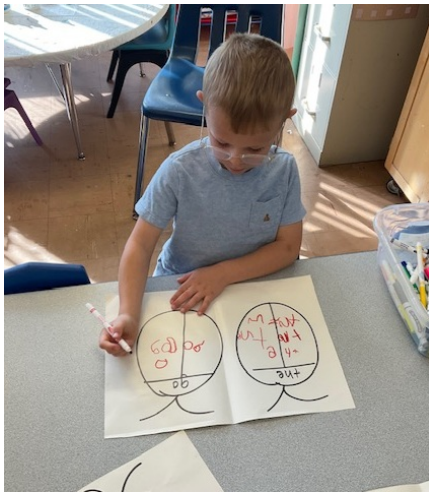
Bubbles- kids will come in dressed in water clothes for a fun morning of bubbles and music.
