Summer Plans

- The Summer is a fun time for the Day Care. We will be having Water Play on **Wednesdays**. Starting the week of **6/22**. Children must arrive on water play days *already dressed* in a **TWO PIECE** swim outfit. They will also need a towel, closed toe-swim shoes, a change of clothes (including sneakers and socks), and a bag for wet clothing.

Tips/Reminders

- Sunscreen should be applied before your child is dropped off. We will reapply in the afternoons.
 - **Sneakers** must be worn daily. We do not allow sandals during the summer months.
 - Please check regularly that your child has at least **2 sets** of appropriate clothing in their lockers. This includes shoes and socks.
 - All items must be labeled.
 - Please alert us either by email, phone, or through Procure of any changes to your child's daily pick-up/drop off routine. This is especially important if someone other than your child's parent is picking up and must be ID'd.
 - Anybody who is not a parent must have a signed "Release Form". These can be given to you by your child's teacher.
- Everyone picking up must have an ID.**
- If the door is locked you must call the office to be let in. Please be patient as it may take some time.
 - Please continue to update us, or the office, of your child's vaccination status.
 - All medicines/prescriptions must be kept in their original containers and held in Connie's office.
