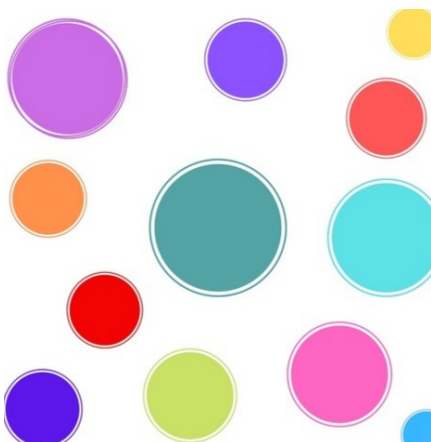

New beginnings

"For many people, the Morning Glory flower is seen as a symbol of rebirth and renewal. It can be used as a reminder to embrace change and new beginnings, even when things seem tough."

We go outside everyday as long as the weather allows, so please make sure to have the appropriate clothing/outerwear for your child.

Our outside time is 9am- 10 am and 2:30- 3:30pm

* There is an employee with a peanut allergy in this room* Please don't pack any peanut butter! Other nut butters are fine (almond butter, sunflower butter, cashew butter)

Tips/ Reminders:

* Please label everything you bring in: Water Bottle, Jackets, Clothes, Lunch box, Book bag, even Socks!

*Sneakers are to be worn everyday, and we recommend having at least 2 complete outfits in their cubby at all times!

*The door is monitored from 7:30- 9 am and then again from 3:30- 5:30pm, if someone is picking up for the first time please have ID even if you're on the emergency contact list

*For safety reasons please make sure all the containers you use to pack your child's' lunch are **Not Glass!** They are starting to feed themselves and we put the containers right on the table for them to eat out of

CENTER WIDE NEWS

Welcome to the start of our **2026-27 school year!** We hope everyone had a great summer and are looking forward to cooler temperatures and the rest of the fun that the fall season brings. The **September Calendar of Events** is posted on the website as well as on the classroom doors.

Tab <https://daycarecentersinc.com/programs/>. Click on your child's classroom name, scroll down to the bottom of the page and click on **Welcome Pack** and **Family Handbook**.

Every child **must have had breakfast/first bottle before** coming to care.

Every child must have a **yearly physical form** with all shots up to date. If we do not have a current, up-to-date physical on file for your child **PLEASE get this done immediately. These PHYSICAL FORMS are DUE EVERY YEAR! We are in our State Inspection window. Without a current physical we must deny services.**

Lunch Orders: There is **NO Thursday lunch** scheduled for the first week of school. (9/7) If you do order lunches, please *remember to provide a drink for the meal.*

*If there is **perishable food** in your child's lunch please label it and we will place it in the refrigerator. Please use **ice packs** in lunchboxes as well.

Safety:

*As with the start of every new school year, we ask for your cooperation with **providing proper identification** when picking up your child.

Since family members are permitted to enter the building, **keep your child close to you and be aware of other cars in the parking lot. Speed limit in the parking lot is 5 MPH. Enter on Central and exit on Spear. This keeps the traffic going one way in the parking lot. Children may not wander the hallways/stairwells without a parent in sight.**

***Entrance/Exit Door** - our main entrance and exit is the **back door off of the playground**. This is the only door families may enter or exit the building. All doors to the building are kept locked at all times. **The back door is manned from 7:30-9:00 AM and from 3:30-5:30 PM daily.**

When school-age children are outside on the playground (typically on Mon, Tues and Thurs) all other children are permitted to use the climber till they come inside. We will be closing the gate by 4:30 each day.

If your child needs to use the bathroom while you are outside and the building is still open, please do not use their classrooms bathroom. Please use the restrooms located by the Care Bear rooms. There is also a porta-potty outside that you may use. Once children have been signed out for the day, they should not return to their classroom. Thank you for your cooperation!

***ID Required to pick up a child. We have 2 people to man the door in the afternoon. They may not know everyone so please have your ID ready and tell them your name, who you are picking up, and what room they are in.**

***If anyone other than the normal, everyday pick-up person (even if they are an emergency contact person) needs to pick up your child, you must complete a yellow release form and leave it at the backdoor desk.**

*All **Children MUST wear socks and closed shoes** (sneakers) to protect their feet while participating in large motor play both inside and outside.

*Long hair **MUST** be pulled up and tied back to prevent head lice.

We hope everyone is excited for our new school!
